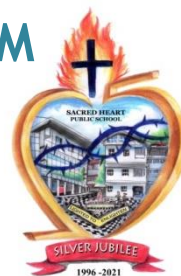

### HISTORY/INCEPTION

Sacred Heart Sen. Sec. School, which stands on the rung of the ladder of excellence today; came into being in 1996 under the precious patronage of the Society of the Oblates of the Sacred Heart (OSH) as a memorial of the platinum jubilee of the Society.

The foundation stone of the school building was laid on 1st March 1996 by His Excellency, Mar Kuriakose Kunnacherry with a unique vision of moulding the young generation into intellectually mature, morally upright and spiritually inspired citizens.

The co-educational day cum boarding school opened on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1996 and was formally inaugurated on 12<sup>th</sup> June 1996 with the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus by the then Minister for Education Shri. P J Joseph. The patron of Sacred Heart Public School is the most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The Kindergarten wing of the school was given a distinct and unique identity in 2000 and named Mar Choolaparambil Memorial Kindergarten (MCM) in memory of the late Bishop Alexander Choolaparambil who founded the Society in 1921. The school was upgraded to senior secondary level in 2004. Since the founding in 1996 the school has gone through many milestones to become the most coveted CBSE Residential School in Kottayam.

The SHPS approach to education has been proving itself for over a quarter century and is reflected by the phenomenal success of its students. The developmentally based curriculum offers an unparalleled and rarest of the rare environment for a student to grow and evolve into the type of young adult every parent wants, one who is inquisitive, vivacious, and well-adjusted.

Sacred Heart Public School which had its humble beginning in a tiny seed sown years back has now grown into a mighty tree providing a salubrious shelter to its students, teachers and parents. And what it is today is due to the untiring and persevering efforts, dedication and

vision of its founders and those who came after them, and above all due to the providence of God who guided this institution.

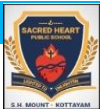
